
No underwear is to be worn with costumes (unless specified).

All students will wear theatrical pink, full length stockings for ballet items. Lyrical and Contemp items will be clarified on costume notes. All tights must be purchased from Stepping Out.

All students from TINY TOTS upwards are required to wear makeup so that they do not appear washed out under bright stage lights. BABY BALLET are required to wear red lipstick only, the rest of the makeup is optional.




